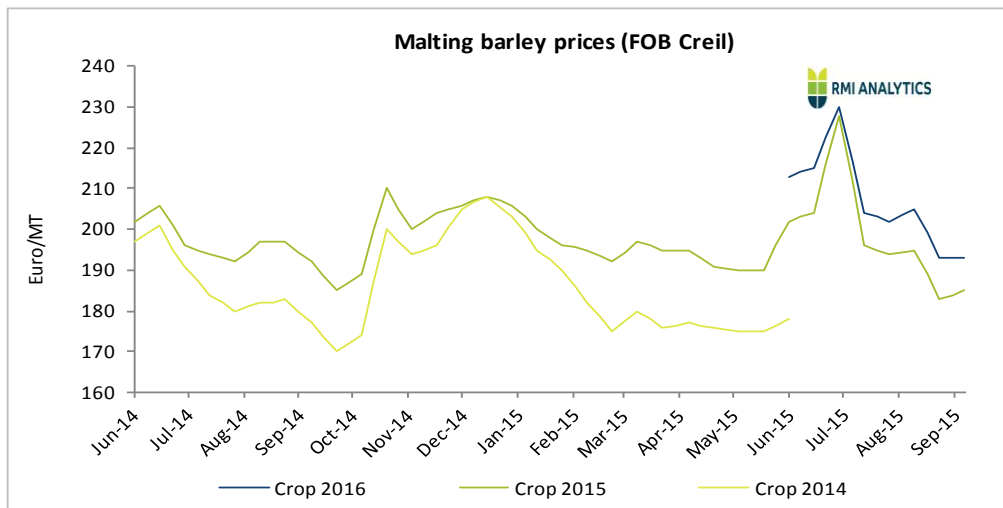
Barley rises slightly in Europe suggesting markets may have found their bottom.
