EU markets remain subdued but some more liquidity is seen.

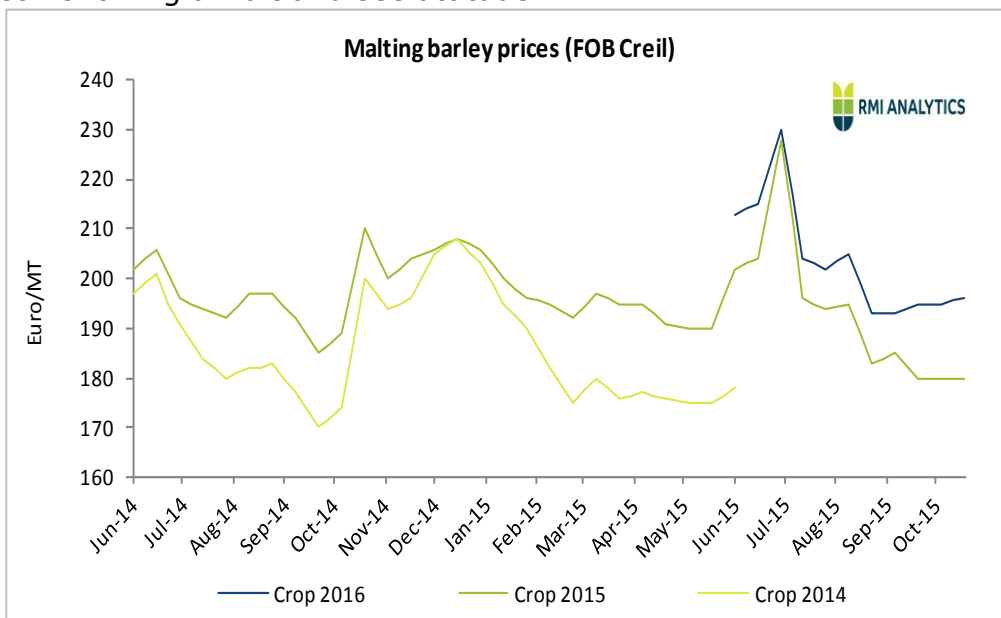
The Canadian harvest is finished with concerns over low soil moisture looking towards next season.
